## Welcome Home - The Lost Are Now Found

- Lost child. The announcement and thought takes our breath away.
  - Parent/Grandparent looks up child nowhere to be seen.
  - Spring into action scan, search, contact the store employee
  - We have a lost child. Associates, take your stations.
  - The action plan implemented. The search is on.
  - The announcement: *The child has been found*.
    - If found quickly tension eases. We carry on.
    - If it takes awhile applause, cheers go up. Thank God.
- God's response to *a lost child*.
  - No panic. He's God. He doesn't deal with the unknown like we do.
  - Point of these parables: God acts with urgency out of passionate care.
    - Like the shepherd. Like the woman.
  - He desperately wants to reclaim the lost.
    - The intensity of search is mirrored by the intensity of rejoicing.
    - Gods is engaged!

## **\*** What does it mean to be lost?

- Unbelievers. Those who don't know Jesus. Hell's residents. Yes, but...
- The Lost a term coming from the Lost sheep, coin, and son.
- What makes each one *lost*?
  - The sheep and son greener grass. OK, but not the coin.
  - Lost = not safe with the master. Do you see that?
    - Separated from the master, his care, and protection
- *The Lost* are those **separated** from the Lord **not safe with him**.
- Contrast: those safe with the Lord are saved.
  - If not safe with Jesus on your own for protection, safety, life
  - Delusions of self-reliance crash when death claims the lost.
  - The lost sheep are the Lion's lunch, after Satan toys with them
  - The Lord desperately longs to rob death and Satan of these victories.
  - Goal: bring the *Lost* back into Jesus' family safe secure prospering
- The religious moralist saw the *lost* as social garbage to dispose of
- Each a *lost cause* not worth reaching and rescuing.
- In fact the self-righteous who think they're secure are totally lost.

## **❖** The Lost Are Now Found

- The verse before our text: "Whoever has ears to hear, let them hear."
- Who was listening to Jesus?
  - 1 Now the tax collectors and sinners were all gathering around to hear Jesus. 2 But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them."
- The *social discards* came to listen.
  - Jesus offered God's restoring forgiveness, liberating from both sin's guilt and reign over their life. Giving each a place in God's family.
- The self-righteous didn't listen. They lectured. = Lost
  - This is the sin Jesus came to rescue us from.
- Faith listens to Jesus since it discovered: Jesus as totally trustworthy.
  - Jesus said he would die for us and rise to give us life. He did. B-I-G!
  - He loved everyone enough to speak truth rescue from sin's lies.
  - He's the Son who kept all the Father's promises.
  - The only place we're safe from lies, death, & Satan is with Jesus.
  - Gathered to Jesus: The Lost Are Now Found back with our Father.
- Lost found: Every moment we return to Jesus and listen to him
  - Every time we gather here to hear: forgiven, loved, follow (vs. scatter)
- Every week we confess **our lostness** separation from God.
  - We can't wait to hear: Forgiven child of God.
  - God's saving work constantly seeking & saving.
  - Those who humbly know this:
    - feel for the Lost
    - $\ ^{\square}$  show mercy we show them mercy share Jesus
    - $\ ^{\square}$  rejoice when an absent member of our family comes to listen
    - <sup>n</sup> rejoice when someone living in darkness is drawn to Jesus.
  - Knowing our sin we have no room to look down on anyone.
  - Only room to look up to Jesus and share him.
- "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." Luke 19:10
  - This is our sure hope living and listening in his family.
  - This is our mission: Called to seek and save in Jesus' name.

Associates, take your stations. The search is on in Jesus' name. For in Jesus
