



First Reading Ezekiel 33:7–11

After Cain killed Abel, God confronted Cain. Cain tried to pretend he was innocent. Cain said, "Am I my brother's keeper?" In our passage in Ezekiel, God affirms that we are our brother's keeper. God tells us that we are "watchmen" for fellow believers. We are responsible if they die while we remain silent.

<sup>7</sup>"Son of man, I have made you a watchman for the people of Israel; so hear the word I speak and give them warning from me. <sup>8</sup>When I say to the wicked, 'You wicked person, you will surely die,' and you do not speak out to dissuade them from their ways, that wicked person will die for their sin, and I will hold you accountable for their blood. <sup>9</sup>But if you do warn the wicked person to turn from their ways and they do not do so, they will die for their sin, though you yourself will be saved.


<sup>10</sup>"Son of man, say to the Israelites, 'This is what you are saying: "Our offenses and sins weigh us down, and we are wasting away because of them. How then can we live?" ' <sup>11</sup>Say to them, 'As surely as I live, declares the Sovereign LORD, I take no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but rather that they turn from their ways and live. Turn! Turn from your evil ways! Why will you die, people of Israel?'



Second Reading Galatians 2:11–16

What does it mean to be my brother's "keeper"? What does 'keeper' mean? Another translation says 'guardian'. But what does that mean? Our passage in Galatians starts to unfold the meaning. The apostle Paul saw that the apostle Peter was being hypocritical. So, he told Peter, and Peter corrected his thinking and actions. Paul was his brother's keeper.

<sup>11</sup>When Cephas came to Antioch, I opposed him to his face, because he stood condemned. <sup>12</sup>For before certain men came from James, he used to eat with the Gentiles. But when they arrived, he began to draw back and separate himself from the Gentiles because he was afraid of those who belonged to the circumcision group. <sup>13</sup>The other Jews joined him in his hypocrisy, so that by their hypocrisy even Barnabas was led astray.

<sup>14</sup>When I saw that they were not acting in line with the truth of the gospel, I said to Cephas in front of them all, "You are a Jew, yet you live like a Gentile and not like a Jew. How is it, then, that you force Gentiles to follow Jewish customs?

<sup>15</sup>"We who are Jews by birth and not sinful Gentiles <sup>16</sup>know that a person is not justified by the works of the law, but by faith in Jesus Christ. So we, too, have put our faith in Christ Jesus that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law, because by the works of the law no one will be justified.

Gospel Matthew 18:15–20

If I am to be my brother's keeper, how do I do it? Do I warn him or her with a megaphone or a blog-post? In our text today, we are discussing sins that are somewhat private in nature. As somewhat private, who can help this errant brother? Well, you can! Follow Scripture's orderly method that encourages humility and repentance. We as individuals and as the Church are the lifeline to rescue the sinner. We use law and Gospel as we present God's message of reconciliation.

<sup>15</sup>"If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault, just between the two of you. If they listen to you, you have won them over. <sup>16</sup>But if they will not listen, take one or two others along, so that 'every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses.' <sup>17</sup>If they still refuse to listen, tell it to the church; and if they refuse to listen even to the church, treat them as you would a pagan or a tax collector.

<sup>18</sup>"Truly I tell you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.




