

## **FIRST LESSON**

# **Deuteronomy 4:1, 2, 6-9 EHV**

Don't let familiarity with our faith blind you to the utterly unique position we are in. Other gods are silent and distant. Our God has come near to us and spoken clearly and completely in his eternal word. Treasure this reality!

<sup>1</sup> So now, Israel, listen to the statutes and the ordinances that I am teaching you, and carry them out so that you may live and so that you may enter the land that the LORD, the God of your fathers, is giving to you and take possession of it. <sup>2</sup> Do not add to the word that I am commanding you, and do not subtract from it, so that you keep the commandments of the LORD your God that I am commanding you.

<sup>6</sup> Keep them and put them into practice, because in this way your wisdom and your understanding will be recognized by all the people who hear about all these statutes; and they will say, "This great nation is certainly a wise and understanding people," <sup>7</sup> because what other great nation is there that has a god as close to it as the LORD our God is to us whenever we call on him? <sup>8</sup> What other great nation is there that has statutes and ordinances as righteous as this entire law that I am presenting to you today?

<sup>9</sup> But guard yourselves and guard your whole being diligently, so that you do not forget the things that your eyes have seen and so that those things do not disappear from your heart all the rest of the days of your life. Make them known to your children and to your children's children.

How can we weak sinners stand and survive the invisible onslaught of Satan and his allies? Fools think they can handle it. The wise rely on God's mighty power, employing the full armor of God.

<sup>10</sup> Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. <sup>11</sup> Put on the full armor of God, so that you can stand against the schemes of the Devil. <sup>12</sup> For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the world rulers of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. <sup>13</sup> For this reason, take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to take a stand on the evil day and, after you have done everything, to stand. <sup>14</sup> Stand, then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness fastened in place, <sup>15</sup> and with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace tied to your feet like sandals. <sup>16</sup> At all times hold up the shield of faith, with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the Evil One. <sup>17</sup> Also take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

<sup>18</sup> At every opportunity, pray in the Spirit with every kind of prayer and petition. Stay alert for the same reason, always persevering in your intercession for all the saints. <sup>19</sup> Pray for me also, that when I open my mouth a message will be given to me that boldly reveals the mystery of the gospel, <sup>20</sup> for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may speak about it boldly, as it is necessary for me to speak.

VERSE OF THE DAY

Jeremiah 15:16 cf. RSV

**GOSPEL** 

Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23 EHV

The heart of our problem is a wicked heart. Manipulating behavior doesn't address our real malady. Wicked behavior merely reflects the corruption. God alone cures wicked hearts with his word.

**M:** The Gospel, Mark Chapter 7

<sup>1</sup> The Pharisees and some of the experts in the law came from Jerusalem and gathered around Jesus. <sup>2</sup> They saw some of his disciples eating bread with unclean (that is, unwashed) hands. <sup>3</sup> In fact, the Pharisees and all the Jews do not eat unless they scrub their hands with a fist, holding to the tradition of the elders. <sup>4</sup> When they come from the marketplace, they do not eat unless they wash. And there are many other traditions they adhere to, such as the washing of cups, pitchers, kettles, and dining couches. <sup>5</sup> The Pharisees and the experts in the law asked Jesus, "Why do your disciples not walk according to the tradition of the elders? Instead they eat bread with unclean hands."

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>6</sup> He answered them, "Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you hypocrites. As it is written:

- These people honor me with their lips, but their heart is far from me.
- They worship me in vain, teaching human rules as if they were doctrines.
- <sup>8</sup> "You abandon God's commandment but hold to human tradition like the washing of pitchers and cups, and you do many other such things."
- <sup>14</sup>He called the crowd to him again and said, "Everyone, listen to me and understand. <sup>15</sup>There is nothing outside of a man that can make him unclean by going into him. But the things that come out of a man are what make a man unclean.
- <sup>21</sup> In fact, from within, out of people's hearts, come evil thoughts, sexual sins, theft, murder, <sup>22</sup> adultery, greed, wickedness, deceit, unrestrained immorality, envy, slander, arrogance, and foolishness. <sup>23</sup> All these evil things proceed from within and make a person unclean."





# WORDS OF INSTITUTION




