

- M: The grace of our Lord † Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you.
- C: And also with you.

#### **CONFESSION OF SINS**

- **M:** We have come into the presence of God, who created us to love and serve him as his dear children. But we have disobeyed him and deserve only his wrath and punishment. Therefore, let us confess our sins to him and plead for his mercy.
- C: Merciful Father in heaven, I am altogether sinful from birth. In countless ways I have sinned against you and do not deserve to be called your child. But trusting in Jesus, my Savior, I pray: Have mercy on me according to your unfailing love. Cleanse me from my sin, and take away my guilt.
- M: God, our heavenly Father, has forgiven all your sins. By the perfect life and innocent death of our Lord Jesus Christ, he has removed your guilt forever. You are his own dear child. May God give you strength to live according to his will.
- C: Amen.

#### THE WORD

FIRST LESSON Isaiah 35:4-7a EHV

Isaiah comforts those who listen to God's word, "Be strong! Your strong Deliverer is coming." Isaiah paints a picture of the physical and spiritual impact of our God who comes to our rescue.

<sup>4</sup> Tell those who have a fearful heart:

Be strong.

Do not be afraid.

Look! Your God will come with vengeance.

With God's own retribution, he will come and save you.

- Then the eyes of the blind will be opened, and the ears of the deaf will be unplugged.
- The crippled will leap like a deer, and the tongue of the mute will sing for joy. Waters will flow in the wilderness, and streams in the wasteland.
- The burning sand will become a pool, and in the thirsty ground there will be springs of water. There will be grass, reeds, and rushes where the haunts of jackals once lay.

**M:** This is the Word of the Lord.

C: Thanks be to God.

SECOND LESSON James 1:17-27 EHV

Of all the good gifts our heavenly Father gives us, James notes that our rebirth into God's family by the word is the highest good. The word that gives us life blesses our life as we live it.

<sup>17</sup> Every good act of giving and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the lights, who does not change or shift like a shadow. <sup>18</sup> Just as he planned, he gave us birth by the word of truth so that we would be a kind of firstfruits of his creations.

<sup>19</sup> Remember this, my dear brothers: Let everyone be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to become angry. <sup>20</sup> Certainly, a man's anger does not bring about what is right before God. <sup>21</sup> So after getting rid of all moral filthiness and overflowing wickedness, receive with humility the word planted in you. It is able to save your souls.

<sup>22</sup>Be people who do what the word says, not people who only hear it. Such people are deceiving themselves. <sup>23</sup> In fact, if anyone hears the word and does not do what it says, he is like a man who carefully looks at his own natural face in a mirror. <sup>24</sup> Indeed, he carefully looks at himself; then, he goes away and immediately forgets what he looked like. <sup>25</sup> But the one who looks carefully into the perfect law, the law of freedom, and continues to do so—since he does not hear and forget but actually does what it says—that person will be blessed in what he does.

<sup>26</sup> If anyone considers himself to be religious but deceives his own heart because he does not bridle his tongue, this person's religion is worthless. <sup>27</sup> Religion that is pure and undefiled in the sight of God the Father is this: to take care of orphans and widows in their affliction and to keep oneself unstained by the world.

VERSE OF THE DAY Philippians 4:4 RSV

M: Alleluia. Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice. Alleluia.



GOSPEL Mark 7:31-37 EHV

Jesus demonstrates that he is the One the Father promised in Isaiah. Jesus instantly gave this man hearing and speech – no therapy required. Join the eyewitnesses in being amazed. Jesus does all things well. Listen to him!


**M:** The Gospel, Mark Chapter 7

<sup>31</sup> Jesus left the region of Tyre again and went through Sidon to the Sea of Galilee, within the region of the Decapolis.

**M:** This is the Gospel.



<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>32</sup> They brought a man to him who was deaf and had a speech impediment. They pleaded with Jesus to place his hand on him. <sup>33</sup> Jesus took him aside in private, away from the crowd. He put his fingers into the man's ears. Then he spit and touched the man's tongue. <sup>34</sup> After he looked up to heaven, he sighed and said, "*Ephphatha!*" (which means "Be opened!") <sup>35</sup> Immediately the man's ears were opened, his tongue was set free, and he began to speak plainly. <sup>36</sup> Jesus gave the people strict orders to tell no one, but the more he did so, the more they kept proclaiming it. <sup>37</sup> They were amazed beyond measure and said, "He has done everything well. He even makes the deaf hear and the mute speak!"

The Lord bless you and keep you.


