
- M: The grace of our Lord + Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you.


## Isaiah 55:6-9 EHV

## SECOND LESSON

## Philippians 1:17-27 EHV

Service in the Lord's vineyard is such a blessing! While Paul desires to be called home through death, he equally delights in sticking around to help these believers grow in their faith and service of Jesus.

<sup>17</sup> The former proclaim Christ out of selfish ambition, not sincerely, but thinking they can cause trouble for me while I am in chains. <sup>18</sup> What does it matter? Only this, that in every way, whether for outward appearance or for the truth, Christ is being proclaimed, and in this I rejoice.

Yes, and I will continue to rejoice, <sup>19</sup> because I know that this will turn out for my deliverance, through your prayer and the support of the Spirit of Jesus Christ. <sup>20</sup> This matches my earnest expectation and hope that I will in no way be put to shame, but with all boldness, as always, so even now, Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death. <sup>21</sup> Yes, for me to live is Christ, and to die is gain. <sup>22</sup> But if I am to go on living in the flesh, that will mean fruitful labor for me. Yet which should I prefer? I do not know. <sup>23</sup> I am pulled in two directions, because I have the desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far. <sup>24</sup> But, it is more necessary for your sake that I remain in the flesh. <sup>25</sup> And since I am convinced of this, I know that I will remain and will continue with all of you, for your progress and joy in the faith. <sup>26</sup> And so by my coming to you again, my goal is to give you even more reason to boast in Christ Jesus.


<sup>27</sup> Just conduct yourselves in a way that is worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come to see you or am absent, I may hear about you that you are standing firm in one spirit, contending together with one soul for the faith of the gospel,



## GOSPEL

## Matthew 20:1-16 EHV

God's kingdom doesn't operate in a way that people consider "fair." It operates on God's goodness, his generosity - thank God! Those who obsess on God being "fair" don't belong in his kingdom of grace.

M: The Gospel, Matthew Chapter 16

<sup>1</sup> "Indeed the kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out early in the morning to hire workers for his vineyard. <sup>2</sup> After agreeing to pay the workers a denarius for the day, he sent them into his vineyard. <sup>3</sup> He also went out about the third hour and saw others standing unemployed in the marketplace. <sup>4</sup> To these he said, 'You also go into the vineyard, and I will give you whatever is right.' So they went. <sup>5</sup> Again he went out about the sixth and the ninth hour and did the same thing. <sup>6</sup> When he went out about the eleventh hour, he found others standing unemployed. He said to them, 'Why have you stood here all day unemployed?'


<sup>7</sup> "They said to him, 'Because no one hired us.'

"He told them, 'You also go into the vineyard.' <sup>8</sup> When it was evening, the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Call the workers and pay them their wages, starting with the last group and ending with the first.'

<sup>9</sup> "When those who were hired around the eleventh hour came, they each received a denarius. <sup>10</sup> When those who were hired first came, they thought they would receive more. But they each received a denarius too. <sup>11</sup> After they received it, they began to grumble against the landowner: <sup>12</sup> 'Those who were last worked one hour, and you made them equal to us who have endured the burden of the day and the scorching heat!'

<sup>13</sup> "But he answered one of them, 'Friend, I am doing you no wrong. Did you not make an agreement with me for a denarius? <sup>14</sup> Take what is yours and go. I want to give to the last one hired the same as I also gave to you. <sup>15</sup> Can't I do what I want with my own money? Or are you envious because I am generous?' <sup>16</sup> In the same way, the last will be first, and the first, last."
