M: For the steadfast assurance that nothing can separate us from your love and for the courage to stand firm against the assaults of Satan and every evil, hear our prayer, O Christ.




M: For the well-being of your holy Church in all the world and for those who offer here their worship and praise, hear our prayer, O Lord.

## FIRST LESSON

Joel 3:12-16 EHV

Jehoshaphat means: Yahweh judges. The valley where the LORD gave King Jehoshaphat a victorious judgment over Israel's enemies foreshadows God's final judgment over all who reject him as their God.


- <sup>12</sup> Let the nations be roused.
  - Let them advance into the Valley of Jehoshaphat,
  - for there I will be seated to judge all the nations.
- <sup>13</sup> Swing the sickle,
  - for the harvest is ripe.
  - Come, trample the grapes,
    - for the winepress is full and the vats overflow,
  - because the nations' wickedness is so great!
- <sup>14</sup> Multitudes, multitudes in the Valley of Decision!
   For the Day of the LORD is near in the Valley of Decision.
- <sup>15</sup> The sun and moon will be darkened, and the stars will stop shining.

- <sup>16</sup> The LORD will roar from Zion and shout from Jerusalem. The sky and the earth will tremble. But the LORD will be a refuge for his people, a stronghold for the people of Israel.

## SECOND LESSON

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Romans 8:26-27 EHV


In the previous verses, Paul spoke of the creation groaning under the curse of sin. Now he addresses our groaning and reveals that the Holy Spirit takes our inexpressible longing straight to the heart of our God.

<sup>26</sup> In the same way the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we should pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that are not expressed in words. <sup>27</sup> And he who searches our hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints, according to God's will.!

- **M:** This is the Word of the Lord.
- **C:** Thanks be to God.

#### VERSE OF THE DAY

M: Alleluia. My word will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it. Alleluia.



# GOSPEL

## Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43 EHV

Our longing to live free from all wickedness will be satisfied on The Last Day. Don't let your zeal against evil run ahead of the Lord. The judgment and destruction of the evil is the Lord's job, not ours.

M: The Gospel, Matthew Chapter 13

<sup>24</sup> He presented another parable to them: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field. <sup>25</sup> But while people were sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat and went away. <sup>26</sup> When the plants sprouted and produced heads of grain, the weeds also appeared. <sup>27</sup> The servants of the owner came and said to him, 'Sir, did you not sow good seed in your field? Where did the weeds come from?' <sup>28</sup> He said to them, 'An enemy did this.' The servants asked him, 'Do you want us to go and gather up the weeds?' <sup>29</sup> 'No,' he answered, 'because when you gather up the weeds, you might pull up the wheat along with them. <sup>30</sup> Let both grow together until the harvest, and at harvest time I will tell the reapers, "First, gather up the weeds, bind them in bundles, and burn them. Then, gather the wheat into my barn.""

<sup>36</sup> Then Jesus sent the people away and went into the house. His disciples came to him and said, "Explain to us the parable of the weeds in the field."

<sup>37</sup> He answered them, "The one who sows the good seed is the Son of Man. <sup>38</sup> The field is the world. The good seeds are the sons of the kingdom. The weeds are the sons of the Evil One.

<sup>39</sup> The enemy who sowed them is the Devil. The harvest is the end of the world. The reapers are angels. <sup>40</sup> Therefore, just as the weeds are gathered up and burned with fire, so it will be at the end of the world. <sup>41</sup> The Son of Man will send out his angels, and they will pull out of his kingdom everything that causes sin and those who continue to break the law. <sup>42</sup> The angels will throw them into the fiery furnace where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. <sup>43</sup> Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Whoever has ears to hear, let him hear.

M: Now, eternal God and Father, keep us in the saving faith and so enable us to overcome all things through our Lord Jesus Christ.


# LORD'S PRAYER

#### WORDS OF INSTITUTION



**M:** The peace of the Lord be with you always.




O CHRIST, LAMB OF GOD (Agnus Dei)


#### **DISTRIBUTION HYMN**


