## THE WORD

## FIRST LESSON

## Daniel 6:10-12, 16-23 EHV

Daniel lived in and stood on the word of the Lord of Life, confident that one way or another he would rescue him from the hands of his enemies. By faith, people of the word share the same confidence as we face our lions' dens.

<sup>10</sup>Now, when Daniel learned that the document had been signed, he went to his house. It had windows on its upper story that opened toward Jerusalem. Three times each day he would get on his knees and pray and offer praise before his God. He continued to do that, just as he had been doing before this. <sup>11</sup> Then these men came as a group and found Daniel praying and seeking favor from his God.

<sup>12</sup> They then went and asked the king about the decree. "Your Majesty, did you not sign a decree that anyone who prays to any god or person for thirty days except to you, Your Majesty, would be thrown into the den of lions?"

The king answered, "Indeed I did. The order is established as a law of the Medes and the Persians that cannot be revoked."

<sup>16</sup> Then the king gave the order, and Daniel was brought and thrown into the lions' den. The king said to Daniel, "May your God, whom you serve continually, rescue you." <sup>17</sup> A stone was brought and placed over the mouth of the pit. The king sealed it with his signet ring and the signet rings of his nobles so that nothing could be changed with regard to Daniel's situation. <sup>18</sup> Then the king went to his palace. He spent the night without food, and no entertainment was brought before him. But he could not sleep.

<sup>19</sup> At dawn the king arose as soon as it was light and hurried to the lions' den. <sup>20</sup> As he came near the pit, he cried out in a fearful voice. The king said to Daniel, "Daniel, servant of the living God, was your God, whom you serve continually, able to rescue you from the lions?"


<sup>21</sup> Then Daniel spoke with the king. "Your Majesty, may you live forever! <sup>22</sup> My God sent his angel and shut the mouth of the lions. They have not hurt me because he found me innocent in his presence. Also before you, Your Majesty, I have committed no crime."

<sup>23</sup> Then the king was very glad and said that Daniel should be brought up from the pit. So Daniel was brought up from the pit, and he was unharmed because he trusted in his God.

- C: Thanks be to God.

#### Romans 3:19-28 EHV

Here is the heart of God's revealed word. Our acquittal is exclusively God's work. Faith relies on this work of God and delights in all its implications. If you give this up, your faith becomes a corpse. If you stand firm, you live forever.

<sup>19</sup>Now we know that whatever the law says is addressed to those who are under the law, so that every mouth will be silenced and the whole world will be subject to God's judgment. <sup>20</sup> For this reason, no one will be declared righteous in his sight by works of the law, for through the law we become aware of sin.

<sup>21</sup> But now, completely apart from the law, a righteousness from God has been made known. The Law and the Prophets testify to it. <sup>22</sup> This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all and over all who believe.

In fact, there is no difference, <sup>23</sup> because all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God <sup>24</sup> and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, <sup>25</sup> whom God publicly displayed as the atonement seat through faith in his blood. God did this to demonstrate his justice, since, in his divine restraint, he had left the sins that were committed earlier unpunished. <sup>26</sup> He did this to demonstrate his justice at the present time, so that he would be both just and the one who justifies the person who has faith in Jesus.


<sup>27</sup> What happens to boasting then? It has been eliminated. By what principle—by the principle of works? No, but by the principle of faith. <sup>28</sup> For we conclude that a person is justified by faith without the works of the law.

## Matthew 10:16-23 EHV

Don't be naive. The gospel insults the wolves and lions of this world who trust in themselves. They turn vicious, but in the end they will fall. Stand firm on Jesus. He and his word will never fail us.

M: The Gospel, Matthew Chapter 10

<sup>16</sup> "Look, I am sending you out as sheep among wolves. So be as shrewd as snakes and as innocent as doves. <sup>17</sup> Be on guard against people. They will hand you over to councils, and they will whip you in their synagogues. <sup>18</sup> You will be brought into the presence of governors and kings for my sake, as a testimony to them and to the Gentiles. <sup>19</sup> Whenever they hand you over, do not be worried about how you will respond or what you will say, because what you say will be given to you in that hour. <sup>20</sup> In fact you will not be the ones speaking, but the Spirit of your Father will be speaking through you.

<sup>21</sup> "Brother will hand over his brother to death, and a father will do the same with his child. Children will rise up against parents and have them put to death. <sup>22</sup> You will be hated by all people because of my name, but whoever endures to the end will be saved. <sup>23</sup> And when they persecute you in one town, flee to the next. Amen I tell you: You will not finish going through the cities of Israel before the Son of Man comes.

Based on Luther's prayer at the Diet of Worms (1521) as he faced the papal and imperial authorities

- C: We would gladly pass our days in happiness and peace in an age awash with iniquity. Hear us, heavenly Father, for the cause is yours. Yes, Creator of all that is, your cause is righteous and everlasting. Vindicate your name among the nations!
- M: O all-seeing Lord, have mercy on your church. You understand our plight. We thank you for sending a messenger of peace to correct the times between life and death. This One is your Son, Jesus the Christ, the incarnate Savior, who saves us from calamities that plague your church.
