Discover the humblingly awesome role: Servant to All in Christ

- Young children: one minute eager to help/serve next: self-centered
- Children: caring/humble then: plotting to be important
- Adults: first to respond to disaster turn around: out for self-advancement
- Humane in special needs less humane in daily relationships
- Best of humanity Worst of humanity: different people, even same person
- Example of the 12 in this account
- Eager to serve in a prominent position
- Ashamed of their arrogance tried to hide it from Jesus
- They hadn't discovered: *There's no "I" in servant.*
- The arrogant can't serve. Their "*I*"s get in the way of seeing service.
- The 12 struggle with this. So do we. All sin is self-serving!

Jesus invites us to...

Discover the humblingly awesome role: Servant to All in Christ

- Contrast Jesus the Servant of the LORD
 - Service is Jesus' First name, Last name, and Middle name
 - Isaiah revealed the Messiah's role: Suffering Servant of the LORD
 - Mission: to serve God taking on the form of a servant to do God's work
 - Mission: to serve All us rebel people who serve self vs. God
 - Jesus served in the place we could not serve and survive: cross & hell
 - When he tells the 12 didn't get it didn't want to. It didn't sound good
 - Mission: to free us from serving sin to serve God, our *designed for* role
 - Jesus had to free us and model Servant of God to see it's awesome!
 - But modeling it isn't good enough. We need a change of heart.
 - Sin prevents us from seeing it is good
 - Sin hates serving God. Sinners are incapable of loving & serving God
- ✤ Jesus exposes that serving God requires more than just doing service.
 - Why do people serve? Why do people offer humble sacrificial service?
 - Conscience: They feel they have to. They couldn't live with themselves
 - Self-satisfaction. It makes me feel good. I like to help. Even anonymous
 - It's wise. It works. Simon O Sinek: *Leaders Eat Last: Why Some Teams Pull Together and Others Don't* - It is in the interest of us.
 - Social standing makes me look good be remembered/not forgotten
 - What's the common threat? Me, Myself, and I What's missing? God

Such good and noble deeds make a difference in society. All are blessed by such service. Christians call this *Civic Righteousness*. God blesses us through this. It is obviously better than inaction or looting and stealing! But when done for *Self* the god they serve is *Self*. They don't know the joy of being God's servant.

- $\boldsymbol{\diamondsuit}$ The key: discovering how Jesus' cross makes you his servant
 - The cross All about humiliating its victim. It says: You're a NOBODY.
 - In humble service Jesus headed to the cross. He didn't just accept it!
 - Why? Yes to serve God and carry out his plan for atonement.
 - Why? To serve us, seeking our highest good to redeem us:
 - To rescue us from slavery to self-seeking self destruction.
 - To release us to freely serve our Creator and Savior God of Life.
 - Hearts of cold stone melted by this Love see the Servant as awesome!
 - Faith trusts and relies on Jesus, puts ourselves **under** his care.
 - Living in the Kingdom of the Servant, our delight: to be his servants
 - Like Jesus, his servants are too busy serving to think about what's *fair*
 - Jesus didn't die for us because that was *fair*. Love made it necessary.
 - The cross infects our thinking. All we want is what Jesus wants.
- ✤ Avoiding the trap of letting sin misuse our service
 - If you are willing to serve, people are willing to let you and misuse you.
 - Solution: be clear in the mission of your service to All.
 - Jesus didn't let the crowd suck him into serving them and lose his focus
 - Jesus left to equip the 12, preparing them to see his cross and serve.
 - Parents don't serve kids to give what they want, but what they need.
 - Christians live to serve to free people from sin through knowing Jesus.
 - Christians humbly serve, doing dirty work, but not *rugging it*
 - *Rugging it* = letting people constantly walk All over you, wipe feet
 - If my service enables, thus promoting sin, that's not Christ-like service!
 - Don't respond with anger and hate (expected).
 - Does this give you joy? I will not Allow it, because it doesn't help you.
 - Discover the humblingly awesome role: Servant to All in Christ
 - Jesus' love that made you a servant humbles you to be called a servant
 - Jesus' love motivates to reveal Jesus' heart-changing/life-changing love
 - A Servant of All in Christ serves for the good of others as God defines
 - A Servant of All in Christ focuses on: the Servant Savior the mission the enslaved & hurting the role
