Live - living and breathing God's promise to be your God

Problem solving can be a great teaching tool

- Reveals skills, abilities, resources you have
- Exposes how you think its limits, good thinking to be developed
- Exposes your assumptions and self-imposed limitations
- Jesus gave the 12 a problem to solve a day long test
 - Test: How would they apply what they learned on their mission trip? Sent to live under God's promise: your God graciously provides
 - Catechism: I believe that God made me ... gave me ... still preserves me by richly and daily providing ... God also preserves me... Catechism 1st Art.
 - God doesn't act on a whim. He promises: *He daily and richly...*
 - Truth not just to explain. Reality: how I see life, what expect, breathe
 - Our test: Are we relying on this living & breathing God's promise?

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What does such a life look like? Look to our Brother and Savior Jesus

- ❖ God's promise shapes our **expectation** and **problem solving** breathing
 - The 12's problem solving **exposes the problem**: people-limited thinking
 - Philip: a well padded bank account couldn't provide appetizers
 - Andrew: resources on hand: 5 barley loaves + 2 fish = virtually nothing
 - Other Gospel: Jesus, send them off to buy their own...
 - Focused on God's normal ways of providing through people & things
 - They failed to apply what they had learned so far
 - God provided as needed on their mission travel as promised
 - Jesus is the Son of God who turned water to wine, etc.
 - Respond: Lord you promise. You are capable of giving *more than we ask or image*. Jesus, what do you have in mind? (ex. Manna & 1st Lesson)
 - With this event: The God who promises to take care of us with grace:
 - Shows us what he can do his power and wisdom have no limits
 - It's undeserved love. Sinners don't deserve it. This crowd... Us...
 - Baptized: live & breathe **his promise**: *He's our God, we're his people*.
 - God I expect you to provide. What do you have in mind?
 - Use me to do your work. Note: the 12 servers...
 - God rarely works miracles, but regularly works wonders. Expect it.

- ❖ Seeing everything is from God's grace we breathe thanksgiving
 - Jesus then took the bread, gave thanks, and distributed ...
 - How do you view meal prayers and giving of thanks?
 - As a godly expectation we owe it to God?
 - As a nice habit if you think of it, feel like it, don't embarrass yourself?
 - Something parents teach children to do i.e. for children?
 - When you see every good and perfect gift comes from the Father....
 - Neither hard work, Mother Nature, or my money give anything w/o God
 - ◆ All this God does only because he is my good and merciful Father in heave, and not because I have earned or deserved it. Catechism 1st Article
 - Everything good I have, get, experience God is the active giver
 - Living & breathing this truth I live & breathe thanks. It's woven into my new fabric.
- ❖ Steward God's gracious gifts with respect and generosity a way of life
 - "Gather the pieces that are left over. Let nothing be wasted."
 - 12 baskets (3-6 5 gal. buckets) More than they started with!
 - Proof of the Miracle pieces of the 5 barley loaves left over
 - Proof of God's gracious giving made rich in every way.
 - Jesus didn't just feed souls and minds bodies too!
 - Our Creator cares about our whole person to make us whole
 - Start: faith, new life, reconnect to him End: bodily Resurrection
 - Just because it's free to you doesn't mean it's cheap/of little value
 - Don't value like the world with a price tag earth bound value system
 - Every breath, bite, sight, sound, touch, word of God = God's gift
 - Value asking: God how do you want me to recognize this as your gift?
 - That's Christian Stewardship of all God gives: physical & Spiritual
 - Overwhelming! How can I care for it all?
 - Those who know God's will seek to use his gifts to do his will
 - **Be generous** like our God. Stewardship is **not** spelled: C.H.E.A.P.
 - Those who live and breath God's promises of grace are giving!

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
