Daily delight in the humble service of your guardians -God's faithful angels.

How frequently do you think about angels - holy angels & evil angels?

- Dr. Becker (*Wizards that Peep*) warned about the evil angels:
 - 1. Don't deny their existence. 2. Don't become fascinated with them.
- We're well advised to apply this to God's holy angels too.
 - 1. Don't forget them! 2. Don't obsess over them! Examples:
 - Out of sight out of mind. All that matters is what I can see.
 - I think about my angel all the time. I love angels.

Seek a Biblical balance knowing God's facts and God's focus.

Daily delight in the humble service of your guardians -God's faithful angels.

Don't forget them!

- God's facts revealed in the Bible
 - I tell you that their angels in heaven always see the face of my Father in heaven. Matthew 18:10b
 - Angels (messengers) created spirit beings (no physical body)
 - Created in God's image tested confirmed in righteousness. Never sinned and never will sin. Gladly doing God's will.
 - Are not all angels ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation? Hebrews 1:14
 - God's Servant Spirits sent by God to serve/protect believers
 - Not just for children. But notable for the vulnerable/defenseless
 - Part of God's Kingdom Care promised in Baptism
 - The term and picture of the Guardian Angel comes from v. 10
 - Clearly God's angels guard his believing children (of all ages)
 - Not teach: each as a single assigned angel nor only for children
 - Facts worthy of your daily delight! *Suggestion* - Luther's Morning and Evening Prayers: *Let your holy angel be with me, that the wicked foe may have no power over me.*

- Focus: angels are fellow servants privileged to serve by God's grace
 - Sin and Satan see angels as God's tattle tale spies
 - God doesn't need their eyes and reports to know what's going on!
 - God's loving kindness for them and us has them serve to rescue us
 - Seen in Jacob's *ladder/stairway* sent out and coming back Gen. 28
 - Petitioning God in our interest with direct access to God
 - They take order **exclusively** from God and report to him
 - Direct all your comments and petitions to God who sends them.
 - Talking to angels leads to putting your trust/reliance in angels.
- Don't obsess over them!
 - They are impressive! We've never seen anything like them!
 - Wise, powerful, fast, skilled, experienced, loving, faithful
 - The Bible reveals all we need to know for our comfort. Stop there.
 - Jesus' teaching on greatness in God's kingdom helps.
 - To obsess over their power and importance misses kingdom greatness
 - To illustrate what God prizes Jesus presents a believing child
 - What makes him great? Ignorance, unskilled, weak, childish? No!
 - Humble not impressed with self, eager to learn and serve
 - You can't be a servant in God's kingdom without a *servant heart*.
 - Angels have servant hearts.
 - Be inspired to humbly serve God along with the angels
 - When John, filled with awe, began to worship his angel guide, the angel said, "Don't do that! I am a fellow servant with you and with your fellow prophets and with all who keep the words of this scroll. Worship God!" Revelation 22:9
 - Our knowledge and delight in the angels and their work calls us to worship their God our Savior God!

Daily delight in the humble service of your guardians -God's faithful angels.

Think about their ministry and give all the glory to God!
