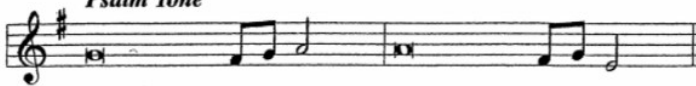
Psalm 40
