

Grant that by hearing and believing your Word we may be healed of all sin and serve you with willing hearts; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.



#### THE WORD

FIRST LESSON Isaiah 43:8-13 EHV

Let the facts speak for themselves. No other god has a record of actions in history. The LORD is God alone. He acts just as he promised and foretold. We have witnessed this.

- Bring out the people who are blind, though they have eyes, and the people who are deaf, though they have ears.
- Let all the nations be gathered together, and let peoples be assembled. Who among them has declared this? Who has made known to us the former things? Let them produce their witnesses to show that they were right, so that people can hear and say, "This is truth."
- You are my witnesses, declares the LORD. You are my servant, whom I have chosen, so that you may know me and believe in me, so that you will understand that I am he. Before me no god was formed, and after me there will not be another.
- I, yes I, am the LORD, and apart from me there is no savior.
- I myself declared it.
   I brought salvation, and I announced it.
   It was not some strange god among you.
   You are my witnesses, declares the LORD, and I am God.
- Indeed, from the first day, I am he.
  There is no one who can deliver anyone from my hand.
  I act, and who can reverse it?

## SECOND LESSON 2 Timothy 4:5-11 EHV

Christian martyrs don't kill themselves for Jesus! They stand on Jesus Christ, even under the threat of death, because the evidence is clear. Jesus is God. Jesus is faithful. Jesus alone gives life that cannot be taken away.

- <sup>5</sup> As for you, keep a clear head in every situation. Bear hardship. Do the work of an evangelist. Fulfill your ministry.
- <sup>6</sup> You see, I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come. <sup>7</sup> I have fought the good fight; I have finished the race; I have kept the faith. <sup>8</sup> From now on, there is reserved for me the crown of righteousness. The Lord, the righteous Judge, will give it to me on that day, and not only to me but also to everyone who loved his appearing.
- <sup>9</sup> Make every effort to come to me quickly, <sup>10</sup> for Demas, because he loved this present world, has forsaken me and gone to Thessalonica. Crescens has gone to Galatia, and Titus to Dalmatia. <sup>11</sup> Only Luke is with me. Get Mark and bring him with you, because he is useful to me for ministry.

VERSE OF THE DAY Isaiah 52:7 cf.

GOSPEL Luke 1:1-4; 24:44-53 EHV

Luke was not an eyewitness of Jesus' ministry. He came to faith through the witness of eyewitnesses. Then, through careful investigation and interviews, he compiled this faithful account under the Spirit's direction.

## **M:** The Gospel, Luke Chapters 1 and 24

<sup>1:1</sup> Many have undertaken to compile an account of the events that have been fulfilled among us, <sup>2</sup> an account like those handed down to us by those who were eyewitnesses and ministers of the word from the beginning. <sup>3</sup> For this reason, it seemed good to me also, since I followed everything closely from the beginning, to write an orderly account to you, most excellent Theophilus, <sup>4</sup> so that you may know the certainty of the things you were taught.

<sup>24:44</sup> He said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets, and the Psalms."

<sup>45</sup> Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. <sup>46</sup> He said to them, "This is what is written and so it must be: The Christ will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, <sup>47</sup> and repentance and forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. <sup>48</sup> You are witnesses of these things. <sup>49</sup> Look, I am sending you what my Father promised. But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."

<sup>50</sup> He led them out as far as the vicinity of Bethany. He lifted up his hands and blessed them. <sup>51</sup> And while he was blessing them, he parted from them and was taken up into heaven. <sup>52</sup> So they worshipped him and returned to Jerusalem with great joy. <sup>53</sup> They were continually in the temple courts, praising and blessing God. Amen.


